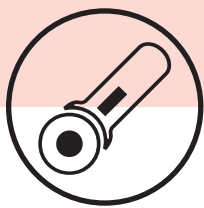


BLOCK HEADS

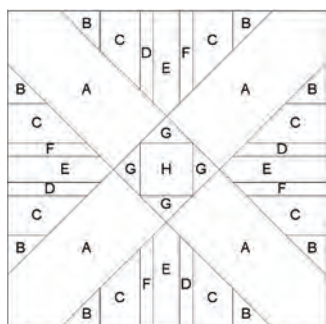
ROUND 2



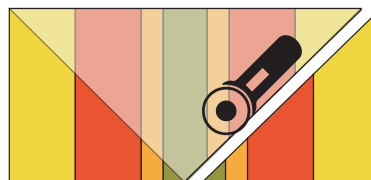
WHAT YOU'LL NEED

For fabric choices refer to the block diagram

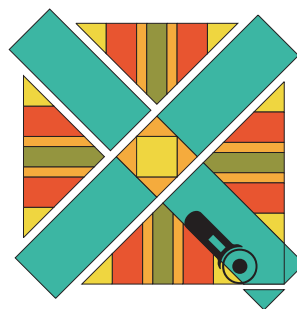
- A:** 4 rectangles 11 1/2" x 4 3/4"
- B:** 8 rectangles 6 3/4" x 3"
- C:** 8 rectangles 6 3/4" x 2 3/4"
- D:** 4 rectangles 6 3/4" x 1 1/4"
- E:** 4 rectangles 6 3/4" x 2"
- F:** 4 rectangles 6 3/4" x 1 1/4"
- G:** 4 squares 2" x 2"
- H:** 1 square 3 1/2" x 3 1/2"



2. Arrange rectangles B,C,D E and F to a strip set as shown. Join to make a strip unit measuring 6 3/4" x 13". With a 45° ruler cut a triangle from the strip set, 6 1/2" height, 13" width. Make four striped triangle units.

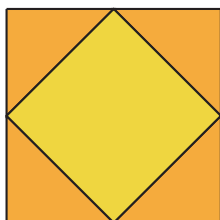


3. Arrange striped triangle units, A rectangles and square-in-a-square unit into three diagonal rows. Sew the units into rows and press. Join the rows and press. Trim to 18 1/2" square to complete the block. Block measures 18 1/2" x 18 1/2".

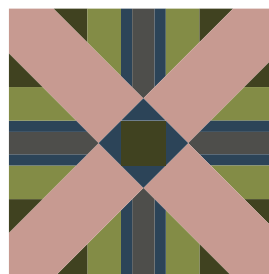


ASSEMBLY

1. Referring to BASIC INSTRUCTIONS stitch and flip technique make a square-in-a-square unit with the G squares and an H square. The unit should measure 4 3/4" x 4 3/4".
