

# 4 Charm Packs plus...

Size: 62½" x 76"

- All instructions include a ¼" seam allowance.
- 22" measurement is approximate. WOF—approximately 42".

## Fabric requirements:

4 Charm Packs: 160-5" x 5" squares  
Inner border: ½ yard  
Final border & binding: 2 yards  
Backing: 6 yards

## Cutting:

For the inner border:  
cut 6-2½" x WOF  
For the final border & binding:  
cut 8-5" x WOF  
cut 8-2½" x WOF

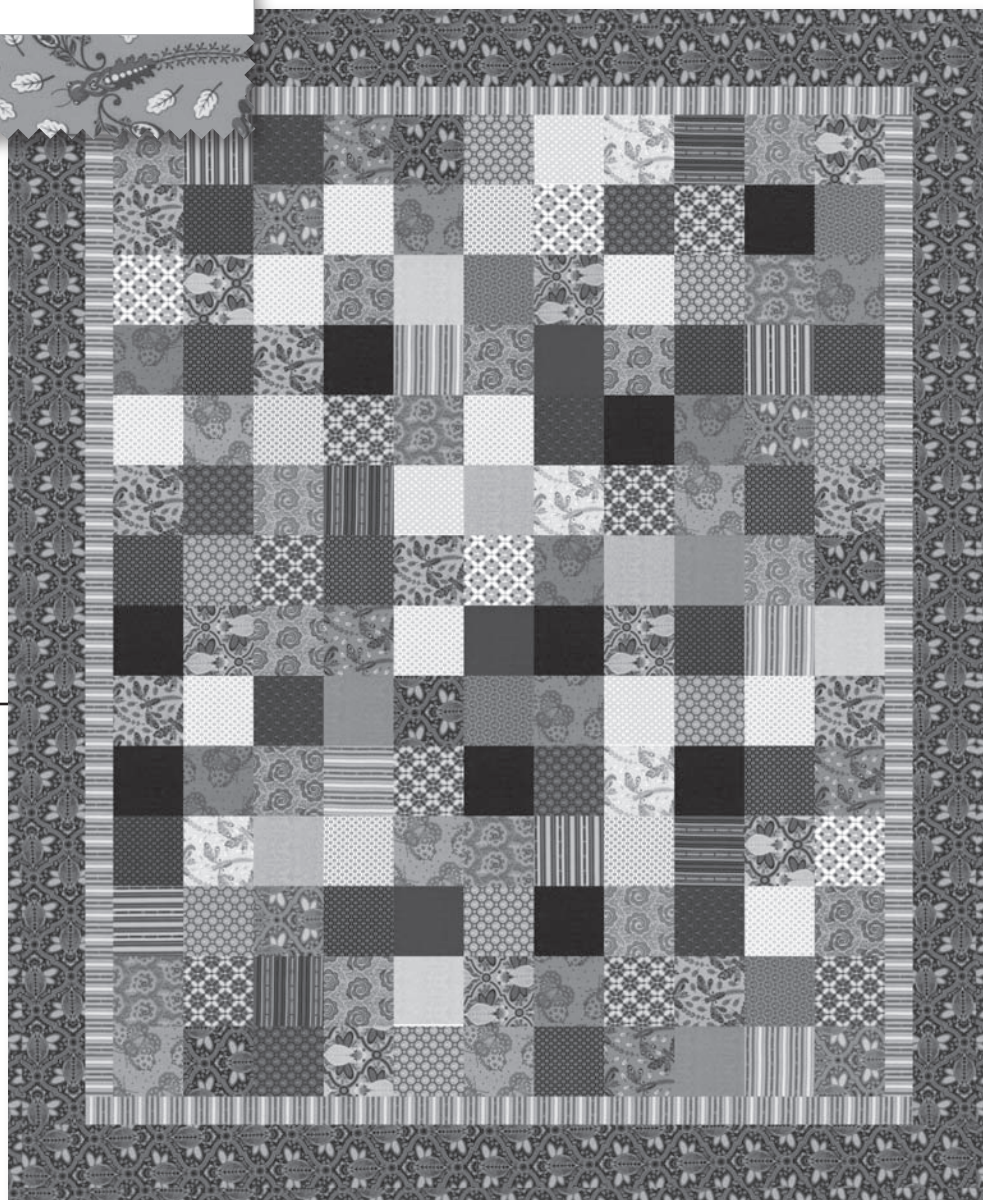


## Cutting your own 5" squares:

¼ yard = 8 squares  
1 fat quarter = 12 squares  
½ yard = 24 squares  
¾ yard = 40 squares  
1 yard = 56 squares

*\*The number of squares and the number of light and dark fabrics in a charm pack varies with each collection. The "charm" of a charm quilt is the mix of fabrics and value. For the fabric requirements we are assuming charm square packs have 40-5" x 5" squares and an equal mix of light and dark fabrics.*

# 4 Charm Packs plus....

- 1 To make the quilt center: sew together 14 rows of eleven 5" squares using the 160 squares from the charm packs. Press the rows in opposite directions. Sew together the rows.

Eleven 5" squares per row      Make 14 rows

- 2 Sew together the 6-2½" x WOF inner border strips. (Each time you add a border measure the center of the quilt for the length of the border.) Add the side borders then the top and bottom. Sew together the 8-5" x WOF final border strips. Add the 5" final borders. Add the side borders then the top and bottom.

- 3 Layer, quilt as desired and bind. ENJOY!
