Caravan Roundup by Marylane

Quilt is 56" x 70".

Fabric Requirements

Boots: 1 Caravan Roundup Fat Eighth Bundle (11640F8)

(Fat Eighth Bundle=30-9" x 22" prints)


Background: 21/4 yards (9900 60 Bella Solid Ivory)

Sashing and boot soles: 1½ yards (9900 99 Bella Solid Black)


Border & Binding: 11/4 yards (11644 11)

Backing: 41/3 yards

Lightweight Fusible Web: 4 yards x 18"







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
Cutting

Tip: Starch, let dry, and press the fabric before cutting.

Background

1–15½" x width of fabric strip From the strip, cut 1–15½" x 21½" and 1–15½" x 12½"

4–14½" x width of fabric strips (see diagram below)
From the strips, cut 1–14½" x 25½", 4–14½" x 11½", 1–14½" x 18½", 1–14½" x 17½", 1–14½" x 16½", and 13½" x 17½"



Sashing

6–2½" x width of fabric strips Sew strips end-to-end to make one long strip. From the long strip, cut 2–2½" x 60½" and 2–2½" x 50½" strips

5–2" x width of fabric strips Sew 3 strips end-to-end to make one long strip. From the long strip, cut 2–2" x 60½" From 2 strips, cut 4–2" x 14½" strips

 $4-1\frac{1}{2}$ " x width of fabric strips From the strips, cut $1-1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $25\frac{1}{2}$ ", $1-1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $17\frac{1}{2}$ ", $2-1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $15\frac{1}{2}$ ", and $2-1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $14\frac{1}{2}$ "

Borders and Binding

6–3½" x width of fabric strips Sew strips end-to-end to make one long strip. From the long strip, cut 2–3½" x 64½" and 2–3½" x 56½" borders

7–2½" x width of fabric strips Sew strips end-to-end to make the binding.



Use 1/4" seams and press in the direction of the arrows.

1 There are 3 sizes of boots; A, B, and C. The diagrams below show how many of each boot type to prepare. Note: The patterns are already reversed. When making a boot that is reversed, trace the boot shape from the wrong side of the papers.


Trace the boot parts onto the paper side of the fusible. Tip: Cut out the centers of the large boot pieces of fusible web to minimize stiffness. Iron, per the fusible's directions onto the wrong side of fabric using the cover quilt as a guide. Cut out along the drawn lines and remove the paper backing.



2 Consider staystitching the edges of the backgrounds to discourage the edges from fraying.


Per the fusible directions, position and fuse the boot shapes onto the different backgrounds following the diagrams.


Stitch around the edges of the appliqués using a decorative stitch of your choosing, such as zigzag stitch using matching or invisible thread.





Join the 3 boot columns. Press toward the sashing.

Add the 60½" x 2½" sashing strips to the quilt sides. Add the 50½" x 2½" sashing strips to the top and bottom. Add the 64½" x 3½" border strips to the quilt sides. Add the 56½" x 3½" border to the top and bottom. Layer, quilt, and bind.
