## Charm Wednesday

## Size: 60"x 80 "

- All instructions include a 1 ¹4" seam allowance.
- 22 " measurement is approximate. WOF-approximately 42 ".


## Fabric requirements:*

9 Charm packs or $\begin{aligned} & \text { 15-light fat quarters } \\ & 15 \text {-dark fat quarters }\end{aligned}$
Binding $5 / 8$ yard
Backing 5 yards

## Cutting:

Light squares
from 90 cut $90-4 \frac{1}{2}$ "x $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
from 70 cut $140-21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
from 10 cut $40-2 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 2 \frac{1}{2} /{ }^{\prime \prime}$
Dark charm squares
from 90 cut $90-41 / 2$ "x $41 / 2$ "
from 70 cut $140-2 \frac{1}{2}$ "x $41 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime}$
from 10 cut $40-2 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 2 \frac{1}{2} /{ }^{\prime \prime}$
Binding: cut $8-21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF


1Two easy corner triangle units are used in the blocks. To make one, sew $1-2 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 21 / 2$ " light square on the diagonal to $1-2^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{x} 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ dark rectangle. Press to the corner to make a triangle. Make 40 . To make the other, sew one $2^{1 / 2} \times 22^{1 / 2 "}$ dark square on the diagonal to $1-2^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 2$ " light rectangle. Press to the corner to make a triangle. Make 40.


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2 To make Block A, sew $1-2 \frac{1}{2}$ "x $41 / 2$ " light rectangle and $1-41 / 2$ "x $41 / 2 "$ light square to one of the previous units. Make 40. Sew $6-2 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 2 "$ dark rectangles to $1-41 / 2 " \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ light square. Make 10. Combine these units with $4-41 / 2$ "x $41 / 2$ " dark squares to make Block A. Make 10 .


3 To make Block B, sew $1-21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ dark rectangle and $1-41 / 2$ "x $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ dark square to one of the previous units. Make 40. Sew $6-21 / 2 " \times 41 / 2 "$ light rectangles to $1-41 / 2 " x 41 / 2 "$ dark square. Make 10 . Combine these units with $4-41 / 2$ "x $41 / 2$ " light squares to make Block B. Make 10 .


4 Two rows work together to make the quilt top. Both rows use 2 Block As and 2 Block Bs.

Row 1 begins with Block A - make 3 Row 1's Row 2 begins with Block B - make 2 Row 2's Sew the rows together. Layer, quilt as desired and bind. ENJOY



[^0]:    *The number of squares and the number of light and dark fabrics in a charm pack varies with each collection. The "charm" of a charm quilt is the mix of fabrics and value. For the fabric requirements we are assuming charm square packs have $40-5 " x 5$ "squares and an equal mix of light and dark fabrics. Fabric requirements are also given for fat quarters. From each fat quarter cut 3-5"x22"strips then cut $12-5$ " $\times 5$ " squares. All that said, let's make a quilt!!
