

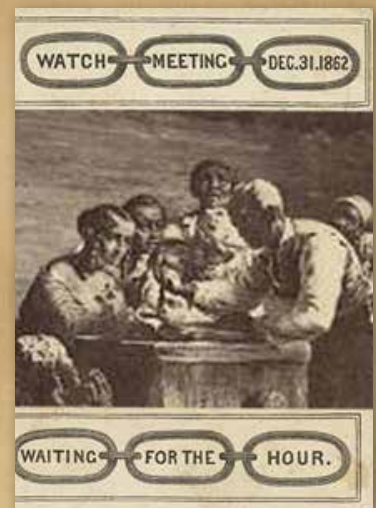

*Read instructions before beginning a project.
 All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance.
 Press as you go. Press seams in one direction.
 WOF = Width of Fabric*

Cutting

*For ease of piecing sort and label all pieces as they are cut.
 Fabrics 1-4 are "lights" and Fabrics 5-15 are "darks"
 There will be a few extra pieces depending on the fabric combinations that you choose.*

Fabric 1

Cut 8-2 1/2"xWOF strips
 From each of 7 strips subcut 2-2 1/2"x 12 1/2" strips,
 2-2 1/2"x 4 1/2" strips and 3-2 1/2"x 2 1/2" squares
 From the 8th strip subcut 13-2 1/2"x 2 1/2" squares
 Cut 2-4 1/2"xWOF strips
 Subcut 7-4 1/2"x 8 1/2" rectangles for centers and
 1-3"x 3" square for inner border corner square

Fabric 2

Cut 4-2 1/2"xWOF strips
 From each of 3 strips subcut 2-2 1/2"x 12 1/2" strips,
 2-2 1/2"x 4 1/2" strips and 3-2 1/2"x 2 1/2" squares
 From the 4th strip subcut 12-2 1/2"x 2 1/2" squares
 Cut 1-4 1/2"xWOF strip Subcut 3-4 1/2"x 8 1/2" rectangles
 for centers and 1-3"x 3" square for inner border corner

Fabrics 3 & 4

From **each** fabric
 Cut 7-2 1/2"xWOF strips
 From each of 6 strips subcut 2-2 1/2"x 12 1/2" strips,
 2-2 1/2"x 4 1/2" strips and 3-2 1/2"x 2 1/2" squares
 From the 7th strip subcut 15-2 1/2"x 2 1/2" squares
 Cut 2-4 1/2"xWOF strips
 Subcut 7-4 1/2"x 8 1/2" rectangles for centers

Fabrics 5-15

From **each** fabric
 Cut 2-2 1/2"xWOF strips
 Subcut 2-2 1/2"x 12 1/2" strips, 2-2 1/2"x 4 1/2" strips and
 3-2 1/2"x 2 1/2" squares
 Cut 1-4 1/2"xWOF strips
 Subcut 2-4 1/2"x 8 1/2" rectangles for centers and
 6-2 1/2" squares

Choose your favorite dark fabric to cut pieces for one additional Block B. From the remainder of this fabric cut:

Cut 1-2 1/2"xWOF strip
 Subcut 2-2 1/2"x 12 1/2" strips, 2-2 1/2"x 4 1/2" strips and
 4-2 1/2"x 2 1/2" squares
 Cut 1-4 1/2"xWOF strip Subcut 1-4 1/2"x 8 1/2" rectangles
 for center

Fabric 16 – Inner Border and Binding

Cut 1-12 1/2"xWOF strip
 Subcut 10-12 1/2"x 2 1/2" strips and 6-8 1/2"x 2 1/2" strips
 Cut 1-8 1/2"xWOF strip
 Subcut 12-8 1/2"x 2 1/2" strips and 2-3"x 3" squares for
 border corner square
 Cut 9-2 1/2"xWOF strips for binding

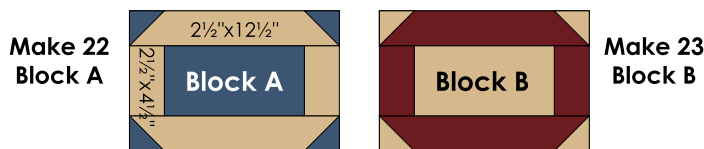
Fabric 17 – Outer Border

Cut 8-6 1/2"xWOF strips

Block Construction

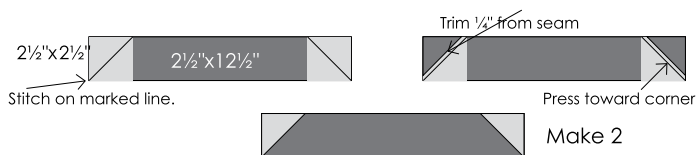
Marking: Using a mechanical pencil draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of all of the 2 1/2" squares

Sorting: To avoid confusion and mismatched blocks choose pieces for each block before beginning to sew. Each block requires 2- 2 1/2"x 12 1/2" and 2-2 1/2"x 4 1/2" matching strips for chains and 1-4 1/2"x 8 1/2" and 4-2 1/2"x 2 1/2" matching pieces for center and corners. *Note: There will be extra 2 1/2" squares. These will be used in the inner border.*

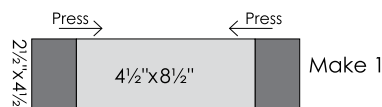


The following directions are for one block. Repeat steps below to make a total of 45 chain blocks – 22 Block A's with dark center and light chains and 23 Block B's with light centers and dark chains.

1. When block sorting is complete, align corners and edges of 2-2 1/2" squares on opposite ends of a 2 1/2"x 12 1/2" strip. *Note direction of marked line.* With right sides together stitch on line. Trim extra fabric 1/4" from seam line. Press triangle toward corner. Make 2.

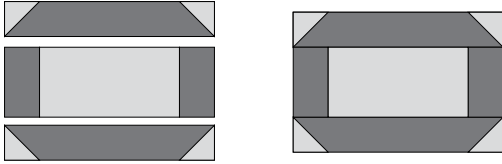


2. With right sides together stitch a 2 1/2"x 4 1/2" strip to opposite ends of 4 1/2"x 8 1/2" center rectangle. Press seams toward center. Unit should measure 4 1/2"x 12 1/2" with seams.



Block Construction - cont.

- Noting direction of triangles sew matching strips from Step 1 to top and bottom of center unit. Press dark chain blocks toward center. Press light chain blocks toward strips. Block should measure $12\frac{1}{2} \times 8\frac{1}{2}$ " with seams.



Repeat to make 22-Block A and 23-Block B

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Assemble Quilt

Note: For best results arrange all blocks on a design wall before assembling quilt top.

Piece 9 rows of 5 blocks:

Make 5 of Row 1 with 3 Block Bs and 2 Block As

Make 4 of Row 2 with 3 Block As and 2 Block Bs

Stitch rows together beginning and ending with a Row 1.
Press. **Quilt top should measure $60\frac{1}{2} \times 72\frac{1}{2}$ " with seams.**

Corner Squares – Fabric 16 2-3" squares and 1 each of Fabrics 1 & 2

Using a mechanical pencil draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of Fabrics 1 and 2. With right sides together align edges of Fabric 16 squares and each light square. Stitch $\frac{1}{4}$ " on opposite sides of marked line(s).

Cut on marked line. Press seams toward dark triangle.

Trim half square triangle units to measure $2\frac{1}{2} \times 2\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Yield 4 units.

Inner Border

- From remaining $2\frac{1}{2}$ " marked squares randomly select 32 dark (Fabrics 5-15) and 24 light (1-4) for inner border.
- Using the $10-2\frac{1}{2} \times 12\frac{1}{2}$ " inner border strips stitch a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " square on opposite ends of each strip. *Refer to Step 1 under Block Construction.* Make 6 with dark corners and 4 with light corners.
- Use the completed units from above to stitch 2 rows of 5. Each row should include 3 strips with dark corners and 2 with light. Press seams toward dark. Stitch to top and bottom of quilt top. Press.
- Repeat Step 2 using $18-2\frac{1}{2} \times 8\frac{1}{2}$ " inner border strips. Stitch 10 with dark corners and 8 with light corners.
- Use the completed units from Step 4 to stitch 2 rows of 9. Each row should include 5 with dark corners and 4 with light corners. Press seams toward light.
- Noting color placement (*Fabric 16 triangles should point toward outer border*) and add prepared corner squares to opposite ends of the 2 inner border strips. Press.
- Stitch inner border strips to opposite sides of quilt top. Press. **Quilt top should measure $64\frac{1}{2} \times 76\frac{1}{2}$ " with seams.**

Outer Border

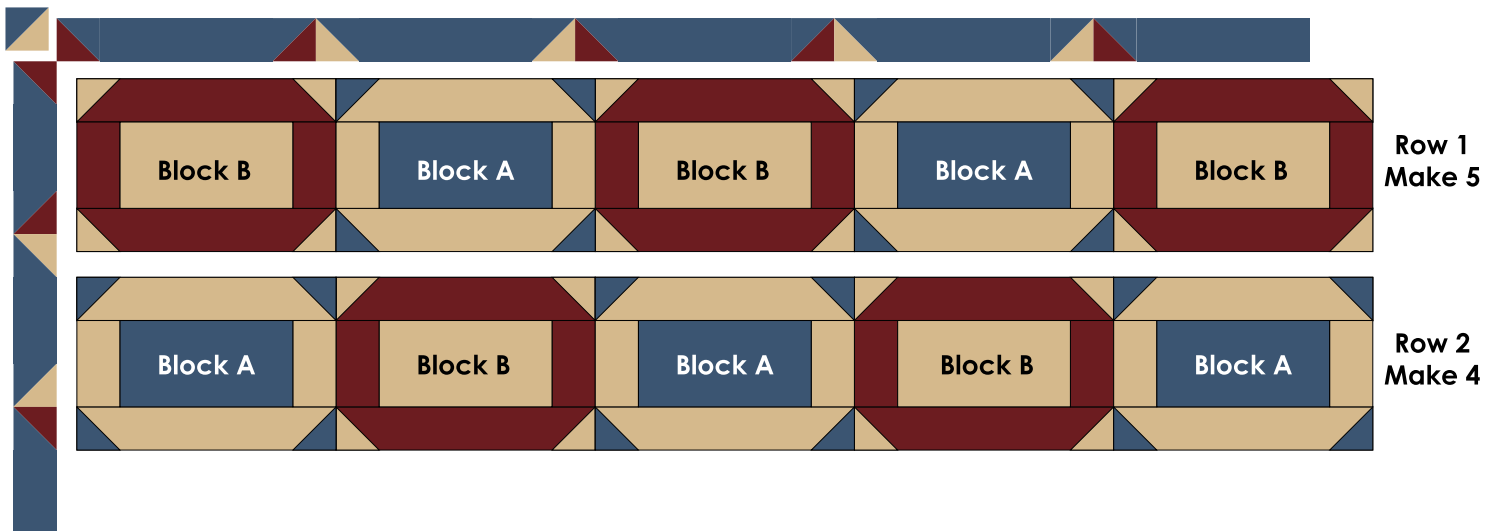
- Using a diagonal seam join the 8 – $6\frac{1}{2} \times$ WOF outer border strips into pairs to make 4 long borders. Press seams open.
- Cut each border strip to measure $6\frac{1}{2} \times 76\frac{1}{2}$ ".
- Stitch a border strip to opposite sides of quilt top. Press toward outer border.
- Add remaining borders to top and bottom of quilt top. Press.
Quilt top should measure $76\frac{1}{2} \times 88\frac{1}{2}$ " with seams.

Finishing

Using a diagonal seam, join the 9 – $2\frac{1}{2} \times$ WOF strips end to end. Press seams open. Fold prepared strip in half wrong sides together and press to make the binding.

Layer, Quilt and Bind
