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## 



Quilt is 40 " $\times 54^{\prime \prime}$.
Fabric Cutting

## Jelly Roll:

Select 8 dark strips for the quilt stripes.
Trim EACH strip to $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 401 / 2^{\prime \prime}$

## Background:

$1-61 / 2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{x}$ width of fabric strip
From the strip, cut $1-6 \frac{1}{2} /{ }^{\prime \prime}$ square and $1-61 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
$1-6^{1 / 4} \mathrm{x}$ x width of fabric strip
From the strip, cut 2-61/4" x $101 / 2$ " and $2-6$ " x 10½"
$12-2 \frac{1}{2} \mathrm{x} \mathrm{x}$ width of fabric strips
From the strips, cut $9-2^{1} / 2^{\prime} \times 40^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime}$, $18-21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares, $7-2^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 2 "$, and $2-2^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 81 / 2 "$

2-2" $x$ width of fabric strips
From the strips, cut 5-2" $\times 101 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ and 4-2" squares

## Binding:

$5-21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{x}$ width of fabric strips
Sew the strips end to end for the binding.

## How to make a Half Square Triangle (HST) Block

Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side a $2^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ background square. Layer the marked square right sides together with a $2^{1 ⁄ 2} / 2$ Jelly Roll square as shown. Stitch on the diagonal line. Trim $1 / 4 / 1$ from the sewn line. Press as shown.



Letter E
Make 1. $61 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 101 / 22^{\prime \prime}$ unfinished

Letter B: Cut 2 sets of $14-2^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ Jelly Roll squares.
(A) Make 3 HST blocks. Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of a $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Jelly Roll square. Layer the marked square on a HST block right sides together as shown. Sew on the diagonal line. Trim $1 / 4$ " from the sewn line. Press to form a triangle.

(B) Arrange and sew the Jelly Roll squares, HST blocks, the unit from A and 2-2 $1 / 2$ " background squares in rows as shown. Join the rows to make a letter $B$. Repeat A and B to make 2 blocks.


Letter B Make 2. $61 / 22^{\prime \prime} \times 101 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ unfinished

L and Heart:
For the L cut For the heart cut

7-21/2" Jelly Roll squares. $2-21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 5 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles $4-21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 101 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles.
(A) Make 1 HST block for the L block. Join the HST block, a $2^{1 / 2 "} \times 41 / 2$ " and a $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 61 / 2$ " background rectangle as shown.


> Unit A
> Make 1.
> $61 / 22^{2} \times 61 / 2 "$ unfinished
(B) Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of 4-2" background squares. Layer 2 marked squares right sides together on a $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 51 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ heart rectangle. Sew on the diagonal lines. Trim $1 / 4$ " from the sewn lines. Press to the corner to form triangles. Make 2 units. Join the units and $4-10^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 2^{1 / 2}$ " heart rectangles to make a heart.

(C) Arrange and sew the 6 Jelly Roll squares and a $81 / 2$ " $\times 2^{1 / 2}$ " background rectangle in columns as shown. Join the columns.

(D) Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of the unit from A and a $6^{1 / 2}$ " background square. Layer the unit A right sides together on the heart as shown. Stitch on the diagonal line. Trim $1 / 41$ from the sewn line. Press to the corner to form a triangle. Repeat using the $6^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ background square as shown. Join the L and heart.


L and Heart Make 1. $141 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 10^{1 / 2 "}$ unfinished

7 Arrange and sew the letters and background rectangles in 2 rows as shown. Join the rows and a $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 401 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ background strip as shown to make letter section.


Letter Section $401 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 221 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ unfinished


Quilt is 40 " $\times 54^{\prime \prime}$.

## Fabric Requirements

## Letters and Stripes:

1 From Bump to Baby Jelly Roll (10040JR)
Background: $11 / 2$ yards (Bella Solid 9900 200)
Binding: $1 / 2$ yard (10044 16)
Backing: $3^{1 ⁄ 2}$ yards pieced vertically 22/3 yards pieced horizontally

Featured fabric is From Bump to Baby by Gina Martin for Moda

Arrange and sew the $8-21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 401 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Jelly Roll strips, $8-2^{1 / 2 "} \times 401 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ background strips, and letter section together.
