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Fabric Cutting

Jelly Roll:

Select 8 dark strips for the quilt stripes. Trim EACH strip to 2½" x 40½"

Background:

- $1-6\frac{1}{2}$ " x width of fabric strip From the strip, cut $1-6\frac{1}{2}$ " square and $1-6\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ "
- $1-6\frac{1}{4}$ " x width of fabric strip From the strip, cut $2-6\frac{1}{4}$ " x $10\frac{1}{2}$ " and 2-6" x $10\frac{1}{2}$ "
- 12-2½" x width of fabric strips From the strips, cut 9-2½' x 40½", 18-2½" squares, 7-2½" x 4½", and 2-2½" x 8½"
- 2-2" x width of fabric strips From the strips, cut 5-2" x 10½" and 4-2" squares

Binding:

5-2½" x width of fabric strips Sew the strips end to end for the binding.

How to make a Half Square Triangle (HST) Block

Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side a 2½" background square. Layer the marked square right sides together with a 2½" Jelly Roll square as shown. Stitch on the diagonal line. Trim ¼" from the sewn line. Press as shown.









Half Square Triangle (HST) block 2½" x 2½" unfinished

Construction


Use 1/4" seams and press in the direction of the arrows.

- Letter A: Cut 12-2½" Jelly Roll squares.
 - (A) Make 1 HST block following the directions.
 - (B) Arrange and sew the Jelly Roll squares, HST block, 1-2½" background square, and 1-2½" x 4½" background rectangle in sections as shown. Join the sections.







- **1** Letter Y: Cut 9-2½" Jelly Roll squares.
- (A) Make 2 HST blocks.
 - (B) Arrange and sew the Jelly Roll squares, HST blocks, and 3-4½" x 2½" background rectangles in sections as shown. Join the sections.




- 2 Letter V: Cut 11-2½" Jelly Roll squares.
 - (A) Make 2 HST blocks.
 - (B) Arrange and sew the Jelly Roll squares, HST blocks, and 1-8½" x 2½" background rectangle in columns as shown. Join the columns.



- Letter E: Cut 11-2½" Jelly Roll squares.
 - (A) Make 1 HST block.
 - (B) Arrange and sew the Jelly Roll squares, HST block, and 2-4½" x 2½" background rectangles in rows as shown. Join the rows.





Letter E Make 1. 6½" x 10½" unfinished Letter B: Cut 2 sets of 14-21/2" Jelly Roll squares.

(A) Make 3 HST blocks. Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of a 21/2" Jelly Roll square. Layer the marked square on a HST block right sides together as shown. Sew on the diagonal line. Trim 1/4" from the sewn line. Press to form a triangle.












(B) Arrange and sew the Jelly Roll squares, HST blocks, the unit from A and 2-21/2" background squares in rows as shown. Join the rows to make a letter B. Repeat A and B to make 2 blocks.







Letter B Make 2. 61/2" x 101/2" unfinished



7-21/2" Jelly Roll squares. For the heart cut 2-2½" x 5½" rectangles 4-21/2" x 101/2" rectangles.

(A) Make 1 HST block for the L block. Join the HST block, a 21/2" x 41/2" and a 41/2" x 61/2" background rectangle as shown.





Unit A Make 1. 61/2" x 61/2" unfinished


(B) Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of 4-2" background squares. Layer 2 marked squares right sides together on a 21/2" x 51/2" heart rectangle. Sew on the diagonal lines. Trim 1/4" from the sewn lines. Press to the corner to form triangles. Make 2 units. Join the units and 4-101/2" x 21/2" heart rectangles to make a heart.









Make 2.




(C) Arrange and sew the 6 Jelly Roll squares and a 8½" x 2½" background rectangle in columns as shown. Join the columns.



(D) Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of the unit from A and a 61/2" background square. Layer the unit A right sides together on the heart as shown. Stitch on the diagonal line. Trim ¼" from the sewn line. Press to the corner to form a triangle. Repeat using the 6½" background square as shown. Join the L and heart.



Arrange and sew the letters and background rectangles in 2 rows as shown. Join the rows and a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $40\frac{1}{2}$ " background strip as shown to make letter section.

Quilt is 40" x 54".

Fabric Requirements

Letters and Stripes:

1 From Bump to Baby Jelly Roll (10040JR)

Background: 11/2 yards (Bella Solid 9900 200)

Binding: 1/2 yard (10044 16)

Backing: 3½ yards pieced vertically

2²/₃ yards pieced horizontally
