Quilt is $72^{\prime \prime} \times 90^{\prime \prime}$.
Fabric Cutting
There are four color groups in the fabric line: green, ultramarine, ocean, and orchid. Sort the fat eighths into the four color groups.

## Blocks

From EACH of the four color groups cut
$5-41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 181 / 2 / 2$ strips
$1-31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 181 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips
$5-2^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 181 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips
$5-2^{\prime \prime} \times 181 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips
From EACH of the four prints cut
$2-51 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 181 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips
$2-61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares

## Background

$4-181 / 2 \mathrm{x} \mathrm{x}$ width of fabric strips
From the strips, cut $24-18^{1 / 2 "} \times 21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$, $12-18 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 22^{\prime \prime}, 20-181 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 2$ ", and $8-181 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 1^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips
$1-61 / 2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{x}$ width of fabric strip
From the strip, cut $4-61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares

## Binding

$8-2^{1 / 2 "} \mathrm{x}$ width of fabric strips
Sew the strips end to end for the binding.

Construction
Use $1 / 4$ " seams and press in the direction of the arrows.
There are four color groups in the fabric line: green, ultramarine, ocean, and orchid. There are five different blocks. Each block is made using one color group and the background.

Blocks A, B, C, D, and E
(A) Block A: Join $2-2 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 181 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ and $2-4 \frac{1}{2} /{ }^{\prime \prime} \times 181 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips from one colorway, and $3-2 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 181 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ background strips as shown to make 1 block. Repeat to make 4 blocks, each using 1 color group.

(B) Block B: Join 3-2 $1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 181 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips from one colorway, and $3-41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 181 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ background strips as shown to make 1 block. Repeat to make 4 blocks, each using 1 color group.


Block B $181 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 181 / 2$ unfinished Make 4.
(C) Block C: Join 3-41/2" $\times 181 / 2$ " strips from one colorway, and $3-21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 18^{1 / 2 "}$ background strips as shown to make 1 block. Repeat to make 4 blocks, each using 1 color group.

(D) Block D: Join 5-2" $\times 181 / 2$ " and $1-3^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 181 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips from one colorway, and 5-2" $\times 181 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ background strips as shown to make 1 block. Repeat to make 4 blocks, each using 1 color group.

(E) Block E: Join $2-5 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $181 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime}$ strips and $2-61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares from one print, and $2-1 \frac{1}{2}$ " $181 / 22^{\prime \prime}$ strips and $1-6^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ background square as shown to make 1 block. Repeat to make 4 blocks, each using 1 of the 4 prints.

Arrange and sew 5 rows of 4 blocks each as shown. Press the seams in opposite direction from row to row. Join the rows. Layer, quilt and bind.



Quilt is $72 \frac{1}{2 \prime} \times 901 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ unfinished.

1 Horizon Fat Eighth Bundle (27180F8) (40-9" x 22 " strips; this will give you a generous assortment of prints.)

## Block E

4 prints $1 / 2$ yard EACH
(27190 15, 27194 14, 27190 13, 27197 14)

## Background

$21 / 2$ yards (Bella Solid 9900 200)

## Binding

3/4 yard (27194 26)
Backing: 5½ yards
