## Quilt Construction

All instructions include a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance
Press in the direction of the arrows
$22^{\prime \prime}$ measurement is approximate.


Quilt is $84^{\prime \prime} \times 84$ ".
Cutting
Blocks: Divide the Fat Quarter Bundle into Dark and Light prints.

## From the Dark prints cut:

$11-67 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 22^{\prime \prime}$ Dark strips
From the strips, cut $32-67 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ squares (3 per strip)
Cut the squares once on the diagonal to make
64-67/8" Dark triangles.
$11-61 / 2 " \times 22^{\prime \prime}$ Dark strips
From the strips, cut $32-$ Dark $61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares (3 per strip)
$14-278^{\prime \prime} \times 22^{\prime \prime}$ Dark strips
From the strips, cut $96-27 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ squares ( 7 per strip)
Cut the squares once on the diagonal to make
192-27/8" Dark triangles.

## From the Light prints cut:

11-67/8" x 22" Light strips
From the strips, cut $32-67 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ squares (3 per strip)
Cut the squares once on the diagonal to make
64-67/8" Light triangles.
$11-6 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 22^{\prime \prime}$ Light strips
From the strips, cut 32 -Light $61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares (3 per strip)
14-27/8" x 22" Light strips
From the strips, cut $96-27 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ squares ( 7 per strip)
Cut the squares once on the diagonal to make
192-27/8" Light triangles.

## Light Inner Border:

$7-2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{x}$ width of fabric strips
Sew the strips end to end using a diagonal seam.
From this strip, cut $2-2^{\prime \prime} \times 641 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ and $2-2^{\prime \prime} \times 671 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.

## Dark Inner Border:

8-2" x width of fabric strips
Sew the strips end to end using a diagonal seam.
From this strip, cut $2-2^{\prime \prime} \times 671 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ and $2-2^{\prime \prime} \times 701 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.

## Outer Border and Binding:

(Cut length of fabric; parallel to the selvage.)
$2-71 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 70^{1 / 2}$ strips
$2-71 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 84^{1} 2$ strips
$4-21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{x}$ length of fabric strips
Sew the 4 strips end to end using a diagonal seam to make the Binding.

## Half Square Triangles

(A) Select one Dark and one Light $61 / 22^{\prime \prime}$ square.

Layer squares, right sides together, the Light on the top. Following the 2" Star Singles directions, place the paper on top of the fabrics and pin. Sew on the dashed lines. Use a 50 weight thread and a shorter stitch length.

(B) Cut the triangles apart along the solid lines. Do not remove the paper.

(C) Flip the triangles over so that the Dark print is on the top. Press the half square triangle units open toward the Dark print. Trim the "dog ears" and remove the paper. One 2" Star Singles paper makes 8 identical half square triangle units.


Use 32 sheets of 2" Star Singles
paper to make a total of 256 half square triangle units.

Blocks: Combine 3 Dark and 3 Light 27/8" triangles, 4 half square triangle units, 1 Dark and 1 Light 67/8" triangle as shown. Make 64 Blocks. Combine 4 Blocks. Make 16.

Quilt assembly
(A) Join 4 Blocks to make 1 row. Make 4 rows. Join the rows.
(B) Add the $2^{\prime \prime} \times 641 / 2$ " Light Inner Borders to the quilt sides. Add the $2^{\prime \prime} \times 671 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Light Inner Borders to the quilt top and bottom.
(C) Add the $2^{\prime \prime} \times 671 / 22^{\prime \prime}$ Dark Inner Borders to the quilt sides.
 Add the 2 " $\times 70^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ Dark Inner Borders to the quilt top and bottom.
(D) Add the $71 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 70^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Outer Borders to the quilt sides. Add the $71 / 21 \times 841 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Outer Borders to the top and bottom.
(E) Layer, quilt and bind. ENJOY!
