

## Sentiments som

Quilt is $55^{\prime \prime} \times 64$ ".

## Cutting

Panel: cut $16-5 \frac{1}{2}$ "x $73 / 4$ " rectangles.
Center the design as best you can. We understand that being cloth it can sometimes have a mind of it's own.


## Inner Block Frame:

from EACH of 3 Green and 1 Blue print cut:
(keep the pieces together as they only differ by $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ )
$8-11 / 2$ "x 22 " strips
subcut $8-1 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 71 / 2^{\prime \prime}$

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8-11 / 2 " x 73 / 4 "
$$

## Outer Block Frame:

from EACH of 4 Red prints cut:
(keep the pieces together as they only differ by $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ )
$8-11 / 2 " x 22$ " strips
subcut $8-1 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 9^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime}$

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8-11 / 2 " x 93 / 4 "

## Background:

$1-113 / 4$ "x WOF strips
subcut $12-113 / 4 / \mathrm{x} 1 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$
$8-11 / 2$ "x WOF strips
subcut $\quad 2-11 / 2$ "x $411 / 2$ $3-1 \frac{1}{2}$ "x $391 / 2$
sew 3 strips together
subcut $2-1 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 481 / 2^{\prime \prime}$

## Red Inner Border and Binding:

## Quilter Basics

Read instructions before beginning a project.
All instructions include a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance; WOF=width of fabric.
$22^{\prime \prime}$ measurement is approximate

## Quilt Construction

There are a total of 16 Panel Blocks.
To make one block select:

## 1-Panel

from one Green or Blue Print: $2-11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 71 / 2^{\prime \prime} \backslash \begin{aligned} & \text { note: only a } \\ & 1 / 4 \text { differ en }\end{aligned}$ $2-11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 73 / 4$ " ${ }^{1 / 4 / 4} \begin{gathered}\text { in length }\end{gathered}$
from one Red Print: $2-11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 9^{1 / 2 "}$ note: only a $2-11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 93 / 4$ " $^{\prime}>1 / 4$ " difference

1 Panel Block: Always press away from the block center. Follow the step to make the block. Repeat to make 16. Be careful when adding these green and red borders since the lengths between the sides and top and bottoms can differ by only $1 / 4$ ".

$6-21 / 2$ "x WOF strips
$5-11 / 2$ "x WOF strips
sew the strips together
subcut $2-1 \frac{1}{2}$ "x $501 / 2$ "

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2-1^{1 ⁄ 2} \text { "x } 431 / 2 "

## Blue Flange:

5-1 $1 / 2$ "x WOF strips

## Final Border:

$4-61 / 2$ "x length of the fabric
subcut $2-61 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 55^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime}$

2-61 / 2 " x 521 / 2 "
$$



Panel Block 9½"x $113 / 4$ " with seams Repeat to make 16.

Sew 4-Panel Blocks and 4-1 $1 / 2$ "x $113 / 4$ " Background strips into rows as shown. Press away from the Background strips. Make 4 rows. Sew the rows together, adding 3-11/2"x $391 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Background strips as shown. Press away from the Background strips. *Make sure the Background strips align across the $391 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Background strip. The quilt top is now $391 / 2$ "x $481 / 22^{\prime \prime}$ with seams.


Add the $11 / 2$ "x $481 / 2$ " Background strips to the sides of the quilt. Add the $11 / 2$ "x $411 / 22^{\prime \prime}$ Background strips to the top and bottom. Add the $11 / 2$ "x $501 / 2$ " Red strips to the sides of the quilt. Add the $11 / 2$ "x $431 / 2$ " Red strips to the top and bottom. Press away from the quilt center. The quilt top is now $431 / 22^{\prime \prime} \times 52^{1 / 2}$ " with seams.


4 Flanges: Sew $5-1 \frac{1}{2}$ "x WOF Blue flanges together. Press the seams open. Press in half, wrong sides together. Cut into $2-52 \frac{1}{2}$ " and $2-431 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ long strips.

$\int$ Sew the Blue $3 / 4$ "x $52^{1} 1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ flanges to the sides of the quilt.
Sew the Blue $3 / 4 " x 431 / 2$ " flanges to the top and bottom of the quilt. The quilt top is still $431 / 2$ "x $52^{1 / 2 "}$ " with seams.


6Sew the Final Border $61 / 2$ "x $521 / 2$ " strips to the sides of the quilt. Sew the Final Border $61 / 2$ "x $55^{1 / 2}$ " strips to the top and bottom of the quilt. Sew the $6-2 \frac{1}{2}$ "xWOF Binding strips together. Layer, quilt and bind. ENJOY!


Quilt is 55"x64".
