## Simple Bag

14 " x 143/4" x 2 "

## Supplies:

Bag: $1 / 2$ yard (Odds \& Ends \#12705 14)
Handles: one Fat 8th (9" x 22") (Odds \& Ends \#37049 14)

## Cutting:

Bag: 2-15" x $17{ }^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles Handles: 2-4" x 22" strips


Construction (Use $1 / 4$ " seams.)

1
Bag:
(A) Layer the 2 Bag rectangles wrong sides together.

Stitch the sides. Turn the Bag right sides together, stitch the sides, enclosing the seam.

(B) Turn the Bag right side out. Stitch the bottom of the Bag. Turn the Bag wrong side out, stitch the bottom, enclosing the seam.


2 Bag Bottom: Pinch the bottom corner of the Bag. Measure in 1" and sew. Repeat on the other corner.


Handles: Fold the long sides of the Handle 4 " $\times 22^{\prime \prime}$ strips to the middle of the strip. Press.
Fold again.
The Handle is now 1" wide.
Topstitch on both sides. Make 2.

(B) Fold the top of the Bag down 1". Press.

Fold the top of the Bag another 1". Press. Stitch.

(C) Flip the Handles up. Stitch around the top of the Bag to hold the Handles in place. Turn Bag right side out.
