Assemble the quilt Arrange and sew 7 rows of 6 blocks. Press the rows in opposite



13-11/2" x width of fabric strips



Construction

Use ¼" seams and press in the direction of the arrows.

Four-Patch Blocks


Sew 1 brown and 1 cream 2½" x 22" strip together. Press toward the brown. Make 11 strip sets. (There is 1 extra brown and 1 extra cream strip.) From each of the strip sets, cut 8-2½" wide units. Cut 88 total. Combine 2 matching units to make one four patch. Make 44 total. (2 are extra)








7 Log Cabin Blocks

Follow the diagrams to add the "logs" to make the block. Press away from the block center. The diagrams that follow show the cut sizes of the logs. *Note the orientation of the four-patch and the placement of the brown logs*. Make 42 blocks total.
