Quilt is 52½"x 60".

## Cutting

#### Main Blocks:

from EACH of 12 fat quarters cut: 3-3½"x 22" strips
Set aside 2 strips
From remaining strip
subcut 6-3½"x 2½"

2-2½"x 22" strips

from EACH of 6 fat quarters cut: cut carefully, you'll be using 17" of the 18" wide fat quarter 2–3½"x 22" strips 4–2½"x 22" strips

### Final Border:

 $6-2\frac{1}{2}$ "x WOF strips

# Binding:

6-21/2"x WOF strips



#### **Quilter Basics**

Read instructions before beginning a project. All instructions include a ¼" seam allowance. 22" measurement is approximate. WOF–approximately 40".

#### **Quilt Construction**


Main & Side blocks: Accurate cutting and sewing is very important.

Hint: Use "Best Press" or spray starch at each step for fabric that acts more like "cardboard or paper" than fabric.

These blocks are a mix of assorted prints.

- (A) Sew 1–2½"x 22" and 1–3½"x 22" strip together. Make 36 strip sets. Align the 8" line on your 60° ruler to the edge of the strip set. Make 3 cuts as shown. Cut a total of 72 Main blocks and 36 Side blocks.
- (B) Repeat step (A) using 2–2½"x 22" strips. Make 4 strip sets. Cut a total 12 Side blocks.


You'll now have 72 Main and 48 Side blocks.



Main triangle: Now we'll add the tops. We'll be making 6 triangles with the same print top. There are 12 sets of 6 triangles.

Select  $6-3\frac{1}{2}$ "x  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " of the same print. Sew the  $3\frac{1}{2}$ "x  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle to the top of the Main block. Align the 8" line on your  $60^\circ$  ruler to the edge of the block and trim. Make 6 triangles with matching print tops.


Repeat to make 12 sets of 6 Main triangles with matching print tops.




Repeat to make 12 sets of 6 Main triangles.

Half Blocks: Let's build the blocks following the diagrams.


Sew 3-Main triangles with the same print top together. Press seams open. Add 2 Side blocks. Press. Trim the Side blocks being sure to leave a ¼" seam allowance. Repeat to make 24 Half Blocks.



Quilt assembly: Now that you have made all these colorful blocks it's time to assemble the quilt top.
Combine 6-Half Blocks and 9-Whole Blocks following the diagram. Press the rows in opposite directions. Join the rows.



Add the 2½" wide Final Borders, sides first then top and bottom. Measure across the center of the quilt for the best measurements for the length of the borders. Sew the 6–2½"x WOF Binding strips together. Layer, quilt and bind. ENJOY!



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Quilt is 521/2"x 60".

#### Fabric Requirements

Main Blocks: 18 assorted Fat Quarters\*

Final Border: 3/8 yard


Binding: 5/8 yard

Backing: 4 yards

#8963 Michell Marketing:

Equilateral 60 Degree Ruler 3"-9"

\*NOTE: 11441 16 is used as a fat quarter and the Final Border
