

Quilt is $45^{\prime \prime} \times 45$ ".

Abilalle
Quilt is 45 " $\times 45$ ".
$1-61 / 2 \mathrm{x}$ x width of fabric strips
From the strips, cut $12-6^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles
2-4" x width of fabric strips
From the strips, cut 14-4" squares; cut in half on the diagonal to make 28 half-square triangles (HST)
$4-3^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{x}$ width of fabric strips
From the strips, cut $37-3^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares
13-2" x width of fabric strips
From the strips, cut 50-2" x 10" strips

## Binding

$5-2^{1 / 2 "} \mathrm{x}$ width of fabric strips
Sew the strips end-to-end to make the binding.

Use 1/4" seams. Press in the direction of the arrows in the diagrams.

## Construction

## Churn Dash <br> 1 Churn Dash

To make one block:
Select a set of 2 matching $4^{\prime \prime}$ HSTs and $2-2^{\prime \prime} \times 10^{\prime \prime}$ strips.
(A) Join $1-2$ " $\times 10$ churn dash and $1-2^{\prime \prime} \times 10$ background strips as shown. Make 2 strip sets. From the strip sets cut $4-31 / 2 /$ wide units.


Cut 4 units.
(B) For one block you will have 4 HSTs, and 4 matching units. Keep together.

(C) Make churn dash sets using the previous unit and $1-3^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ background square. Join the center only. Make 25 sets.

2 There is a coloring sheet, on page 3. you can use to decide on print placement or use your design wall.
As you layout the quilt, sew the half-square triangles together first; trim the half-triangle squares to $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{x}$ $31 / 2$ ".


HTS
Trim to $31 / 2$ " square.


3 Sew the quilt together in rows as shown. Press the seams open. Join the rows. Layer, quilt and bind.
