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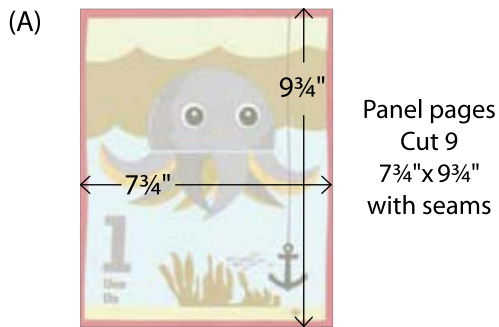
Quilter Basics \_\_\_\_\_

Read instructions before beginning a project.  
All instructions include a  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance  
WOF=width of fabric.

## Book Construction \_\_\_\_\_

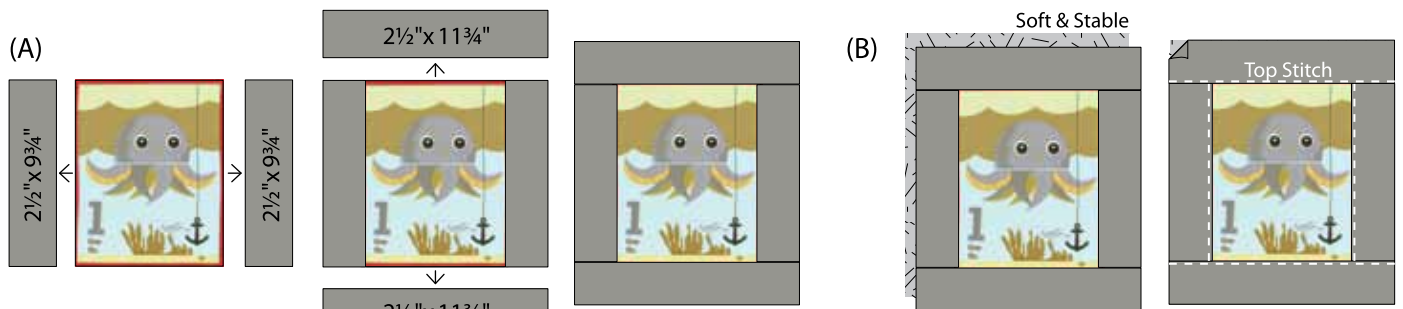
### 1 From your Panel:

- (A) Cut each number panel  $\frac{1}{4}$ " from the border. Each Number Panel should measure approximately  $7\frac{3}{4}$ "x $9\frac{3}{4}$ ".  
(B) Cut the "10 Numbers" panel to  $13\frac{3}{4}$ "x7" centering the word "Numbers" for the Pocket.



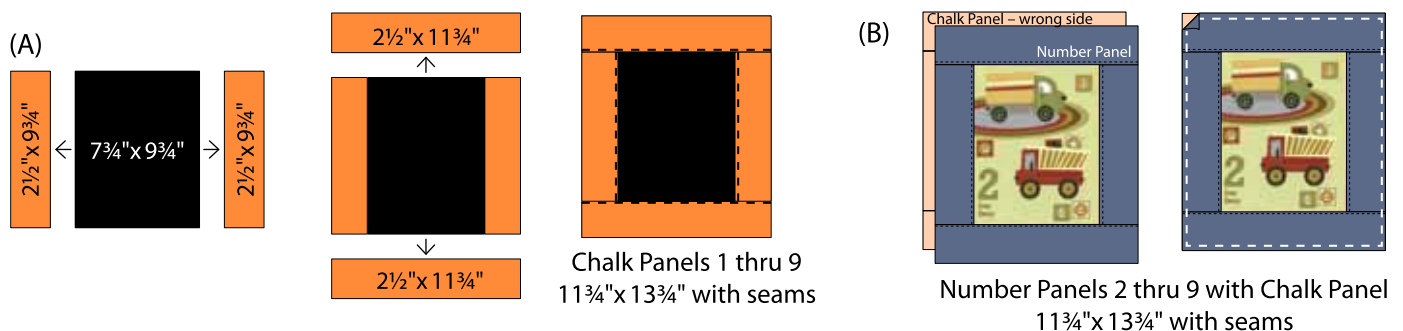
### 2 Number Panels:

- (A) Select 4 matching Jelly Roll™ cut strips ( $2-2\frac{1}{2}$ "x $9\frac{3}{4}$ " and  $2-2\frac{1}{2}$ "x $11\frac{3}{4}$ "). Sew  $2-9\frac{3}{4}$ " strips to the sides of a Number Panel. *Always press away from the Number Panel.* Then sew  $2-11\frac{3}{4}$ " strips to the top and bottom of Number Panel.  
(B) Layer the Number Panel wrong sides together with the Soft & Stable. ( $1-11\frac{3}{4}$ "x $13\frac{3}{4}$ "). Top stitch the borders securing the panel to the Soft & Stable. Repeat with the remaining 8 Number Panels.

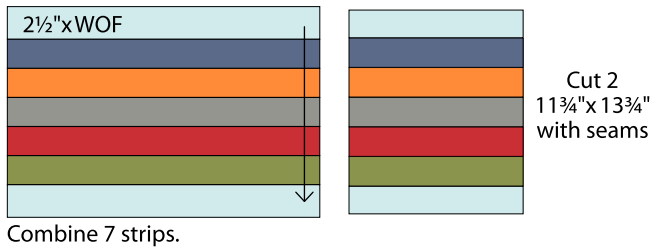


### 3 Chalk Panels:

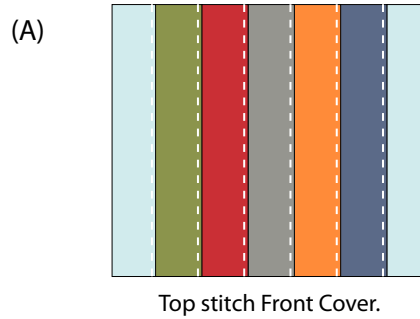
- (A) Select 4 matching Jelly Roll™ cut strips ( $2-2\frac{1}{2}$ "x $9\frac{3}{4}$ " and  $2-2\frac{1}{2}$ "x $11\frac{3}{4}$ "). Sew  $2-9\frac{3}{4}$ " strips to the sides of a Chalk Panel. *Always press away from the Chalk Panel.* Then sew  $2-11\frac{3}{4}$ " strips to the top and bottom. Repeat with the remaining 8 Chalk Panels.  
(B) Set aside Number Panel #1 (the Octopus) to be layered with the Book Cover later. Using Number Panels 2 thru 9, layer a Number Panel wrong sides together with a Chalk Panel. Stitch  $\frac{1}{8}$ " from the outer edge to hold all the pieces together. Repeat with the remaining 7 Number Panels.



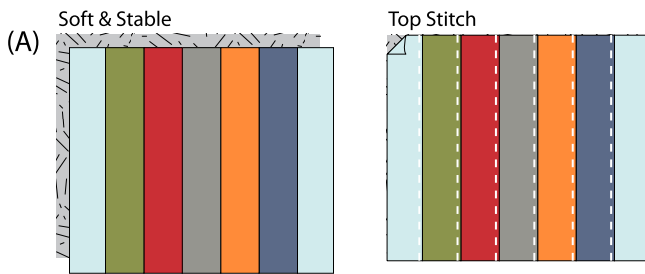
- 4 Panels for Front & Back Cover:**  
 Select 7 Jelly Roll™ strips and sew them long sides together in any random order. Press seams in all one direction. Cut 2–11¾" x 13¾" panels.



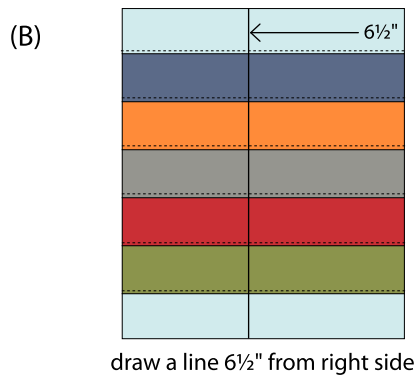
- 7 Book Front Cover:**  
 (A) Top stitch the seams on the other panel.



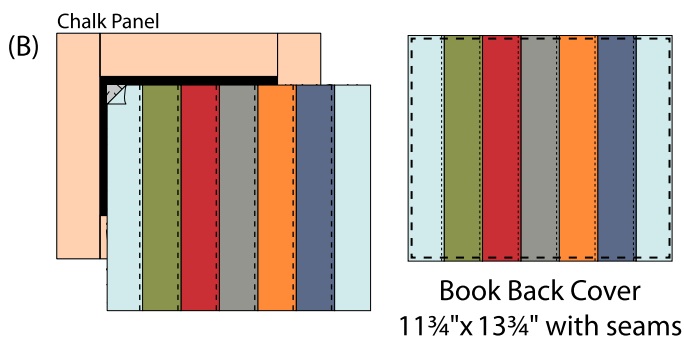
- 5 Book Back Cover:**  
 (A) Layer one striped panel on top of the last piece of Soft & Stable. Top stitch the seams of the strips down to the Soft & Stable securing the two together.



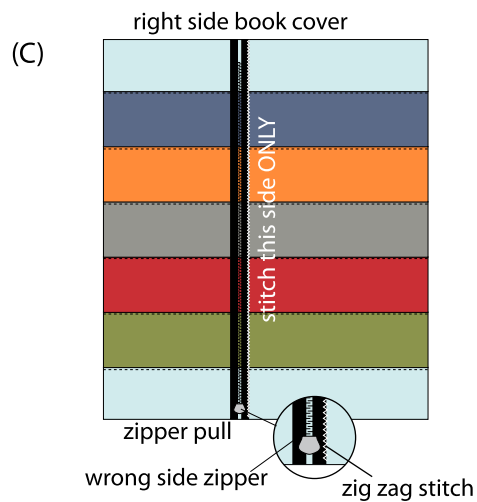
- (B) Draw a line 6½" from the right side from top to bottom.



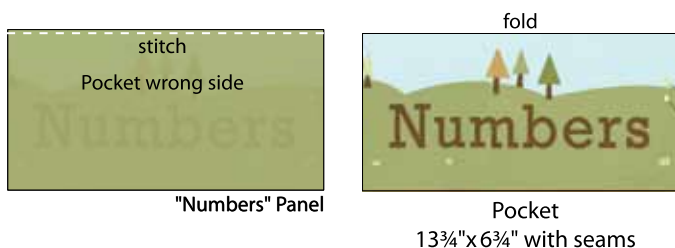
- (B) Layer Back Cover with Soft & Stable and the last piece of Chalk Panel wrong sides together. Stitch ⅛" around the outside edge to hold the pieces together.



- (C) With *right sides together*, center your zipper along the *left hand side* of the drawn line *right side down*. Zig zag stitch along the zipper edge that is against the line.



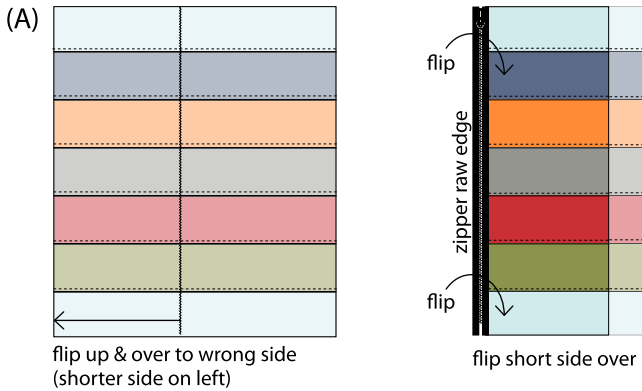
- 6 Pocket for Book Front Cover:**  
 Layer the Pocket (Numbers) and Pocket Lining, right sides together. Stitch along the top edge only. Turn right sides out and press along the seam.



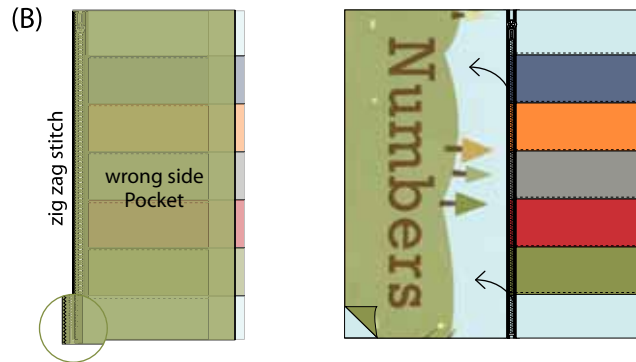
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## 8 Book Front Cover continued:

- (A) Flip the Front Cover *up and over* as shown. Fold the Front Cover back to reveal the other raw edge of the zipper.



- (B) Place the top sewn edge of the Pocket, right sides together with the zipper raw edge. Zig Zag stitch the edges together. Flip the cover right side up so that the striped panel is laying flat and the zipper and pocket are right sides up laying on the right sides of the panel.



- (C) Layer the Front Cover and Number Panel #1 (Octopus) wrong sides together. Stitch  $\frac{1}{8}$ " from the outer edge to hold all the pieces together. Trim off any excess zipper ends.

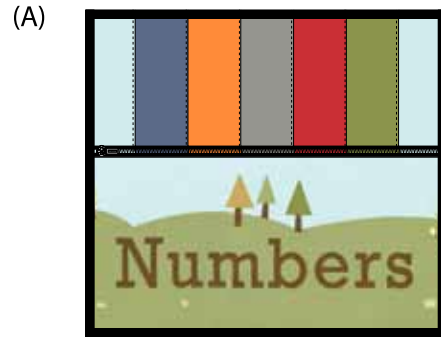
- (C) wrong side of Number Panel #1 (Octopus)



$11\frac{3}{4}$ " x  $13\frac{3}{4}$ " with seams

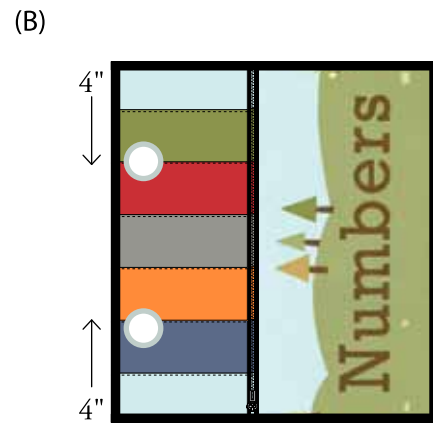
## 9 Book Front Cover continued:

- (A) Bind each page individually as if they were 10 little quilts.



- (B) Following the manufacturer's directions on the XL Eyelet package, attach 2 eyelets to each page on the left hand side 4" from the top and bottom along the inside of the binding.

Layer the book pages in the appropriate order so that all your eyelets line up. Cut two pieces of twill tape measuring 30" each. Slip the twill tape through each eyelet on either side and tie off with a bow.



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## 10 Eraser Cloth:

Match your two pieces of 10" square flannel wrong sides together and serge or zig zag around all four sides of the cloth. This is your eraser cloth. Store the eraser cloth and chalk in the zipper pocket of your book.

**Book Pages:** 1 Ten Little Things Panel (sku 30500 12)

1 Ten Little Things Jelly Roll™ (sku 30500JR)

**Black Chalk Cloth:**  $\frac{3}{4}$  yard (#OC48)

**Pocket Lining and Eraser cloth:**  $\frac{1}{2}$  yard  
(coordinating Marble Flannel)

**Binding:** QB2 4518 (Bella Black premade binding) 16 yards  
or 1 yard of fabric (13–2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF)

**Soft and Stable by Annie:** 1–36" x 58" pack (#S S1036)

**Zipper:** 1–14" Black Zipper

**Eyelets:** 20–XL Eyelets (2 packs of Dritz #660 65)

**Twill Tape:** 60"–ABC or 123 Twill Tape by Moda (#2109)

**Book Pages:**

select 18 strips from the Jelly Roll™  
from EACH of the 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips cut:

2–2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 11 $\frac{3}{4}$ " strips

2–2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 9 $\frac{3}{4}$ " strips

**Black Chalk Cloth:**

9–9 $\frac{3}{4}$ " x 7 $\frac{3}{4}$ " rectangles

**Pocket Lining and Eraser cloth:**

1–13 $\frac{3}{4}$ " x 7" rectangle (Lining)

2–10" x 10" squares (Eraser cloth)

**Soft and Stable by Annie:**

10–11 $\frac{3}{4}$ " x 13 $\frac{3}{4}$ " rectangles

**Twill Tape:**

2–30" long pieces

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
