## Quilter Basics

Read instructions before beginning a project. • All instructions include a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance. $\cdot 22$ " measurement is approximate $\cdot$ Press as you go

## Fabric Requirements

1 Charm Pack (32570PP)
Fabric 1 (32570-11) dogwood print $1 / 2 \mathrm{yd}$.
Fabric 2 (32576-15) pink tonal FQ
Fabric 3 (32576-19) green tonal $1 / 2 \mathrm{yd}$.
Fabric 4 (32574-11) pink and white print 1/2 yd. Backing

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15 / 8 \mathrm{yds}

## Cutting

## Label cut pieces to avoid mix-ups

Fabric 1
Fussy cut $1-12^{1 / 4}{ }^{\prime \prime} \times 42^{\prime \prime}$ strip for center of table runner
Fabric 2
Cut 6-1"x22" strips for inner border
From remainder cut $5-5 " x 5^{\prime \prime}$ squares for pinwheels
Fabric 3
Cut $4-2$ "xWOF strips for binding
From remainder cut $8-5 " x 5^{\prime \prime}$ squares for pinwheels
Fabric 4
Cut $5-3$ "xWOF strips
Subcut $60-3^{\prime \prime} \times 3$ " squares, cut once diagonally for background corners

## Construction

## Pinwheel Blocks

Note: If you would prefer to use Spinning Stars Triangle Papers (11/2" finished) to piece the pinwheel blocks, follow Steps 1 \& 2 and then read and follow triangle paper directions.

1. From the charm pack, select 10 pinks (darker ones are best) and 7 greens. Add to these the (8) Fabric 3 green squares and the (5) Fabric 2 pink squares.
2. Aligning edges, pair 1 green and 1 pink square right sides together.
3. Using a rotary cutter and ruler, cut each pair into $4-2 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 2 \frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

Make sure pairs are labeled and stay together.



Cut each pair into $4-2 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 2 \frac{1}{2}$ " squares Make sure pairs are labeled and stay together
4. Using a mechanical pencil, draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of all the $2 \frac{1}{2}$ "x $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " pink squares.
5. Stitch a scant $1 / 4 /$ on opposite sides of marked line. Cut on marked line to yield -2 half square triangle units. See diagram. Square units to measure 2" with seams.
6. Repeat to make a total of 120 half square triangle units. Keep in sets of 4 like units. Total: 30 sets of 4.
7. Stitch the 4 like triangle units together to make 1 pinwheel block. To reduce bulk, press seams open. Make 30. Blocks should measure $31 / 2$ "x $31 / 2$ " with seams.

## Add Background Corners

1. Align centers and stitch $2-3$ " triangles to opposite sides of a pinwheel block. Press seams toward triangles. Repeat with opposite sides. See diagram.


Square completed block to measure $43 / 4$ "x 43/4" with seams. Make 30 blocks.


## Inner Border

1. Using a bias seam, join the $6-1$ " $\times 22^{\prime \prime}$ inner border strips together end to end.
2. Cut 2 strips to measure 1 " $\times 42$ ". Add to opposite sides of dogwood print strip. Press seams toward dogwood print.
3. Measure center unit from edge to edge, including inner borders. Cut top and bottom border strips to that measurement (approx. 131/4" with seams). Add to top and bottom of center. Press toward dogwood print.

## Assemble Table Runner

2. Add to sides of center unit. Press seams toward inner border.
3. Stitch remaining pinwheels into 2 rows of 5 . Press seams in 1 direction. Add to top and bottom of table runner. Press.

## Finishing

Using a bias seam, join the $4-2$ "xWOF strips end to end. Press seams open. Fold prepared strip in half wrong sides together and press to make the binding.

Layer, Quilt and Bind.
