Finished Size: 70"x76" Block Size: 6"x6"

Quilters Basics

Read instructions before beginning a project.

All instructions include a ¼" seam allowance.

Press as you go. Press seams in one direction

22" measurement is approximate.



Cutting_

Label pieces as they are cut.

FABRIC 1

Cut 5 – 4"xWOF strips Subcut 46 – 4"x4" square for pinwheels

FABRIC 2

Cut $8 - 2\frac{1}{2}$ "xWOF strips for Binding

Cut 2 - 4"xWOF strips Subcut 12 - 4"x 4" square for pinwheels

FABRIC 3

Cut 3 – 4"x22" strips
Subcut 14 – 4"x4" square for pinwheels

FABRIC 4

Cut 2 - 4"x22" strips Subcut 8 - 4"x4" square for pinwheels

FABRIC 5

Cut 3 - 4"x22" strips Subcut 12 - 4"x4" square for pinwheels

FABRIC 6

Cut $2 - 6\frac{1}{2}$ " x 22" strips Subcut $5 - 6\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " squares

FABRIC 7

Cut $2 - 6\frac{1}{2}$ " x 22" strips Subcut $4 - 6\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " squares

FABRIC 8

Cut $2 - 6\frac{1}{2}$ " x 22" strips Subcut $6 - 6\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " squares

FABRIC 9

Cut $2 - 6\frac{1}{2}$ "xWOF strips Subcut $11 - 6\frac{1}{2}$ "x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " squares

FABRIC 10

Cut $2 - 6\frac{1}{2}$ "xWOF strips Subcut $9 - 6\frac{1}{2}$ "x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " squares

FABRIC 11

Cut $2 - 6\frac{1}{2}$ "xWOF strips Subcut $7 - 6\frac{1}{2}$ "x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " squares

FABRIC 12

Cut $1 - 6\frac{1}{2}$ "xWOF strips Subcut $3 - 6\frac{1}{2}$ "x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " squares

Cut $2 - 3\frac{1}{2}$ "xWOF strips Subcut $14 - 3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " squares for 4 patches

FABRIC 13

Cut $4 - 3\frac{1}{2}$ "x 22" strips Subcut $22 - 3\frac{1}{2}$ " squares for 4 patches

FABRIC 14

Cut $2 - 3\frac{1}{2}$ " x 22" strips Subcut $8 - 3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " squares for 4 patches

FABRIC 15

Cut $1 - 3\frac{1}{2}$ "x 22" strips Subcut $6 - 3\frac{1}{2}$ "x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " squares for 4 patches

FABRIC 16

Cut $2 - 3\frac{1}{2}$ " x 22" strips Subcut $12 - 3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " squares for 4 patches

FABRIC 17

Cut $1 - 3\frac{1}{2}$ "x 22" strips Subcut $6 - 3\frac{1}{2}$ "x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " squares for 4 patches

FABRICS 18 AND 19

Cut $2 - 3\frac{1}{2}$ "x 22" strips Subcut $8 - 3\frac{1}{2}$ "x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " squares for 4 patches

FABRIC 20

Cut $1 - 3\frac{1}{2}$ "x 22" strips Subcut $4 - 3\frac{1}{2}$ "x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " squares for 4 patches

FABRIC 21

Cut or tear 4 – 8½"x LENGTH of fabric strips for Border

Construction _____


PINWHEEL BLOCKS

1. Using a mechanical pencil draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the 46 - 4"x4" Fabric 1 squares.

Construction – cont.

- 2. With right sides together pair marked background squares with the 46 4" squares from Fabrics 2-5.
- 3. Stitch a scant 1/4" on opposite sides of the marked line.
- 4. Cut on marked line to yield 92 half square triangle units. Press away from background.
- 5. Trim units to measure $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " with seams.
- 6. Select 4 matching triangle units and stitch together to make 1 pinwheel block. *See diagram. Note direction of colored triangles.*

Make 23 pinwheel blocks – 6 Lavendar, 7 Red, 4 Taupe and 6 Blue. Blocks should measure 6½"x 6½" with seams.



Assemble Quilt_

Stitch the blocks into rows –9 blocks per row. Press odd number rows in one direction and even number in the opposite direction. Refer to diagrams below for content of each row – label rows.

Refer to quilt image for color placement. Join rows to assemble quilt top. Press.

Rows 1, 5 and 9

Pinwheel, plain block, 4-patch, plain block, pinwheel, plain block, 4-patch, plain block, pinwheel





Outer Border



Borders

Note: Border is designed to "chase" around quilt top. Please note direction and placement of flower motif.

- 1. Measure width of quilt top from side to side through center of quilt.
- Cut 2 border strips to that measurement (approx. 54½") and add to top and bottom of quilt top.
 Floral motif should be facing in opposite directions.
 Press.
- 3. Measure width of quilt top from top to bottom including border strips
- 4. Cut remaining 2 border strips to that measurement (approx. 76½") and, noting direction of floral motif, add to opposite sides of quilt top. Press.

Quilt should measure 70½"x 76½" with seams.

Finishing

Using a bias seam, join the $8 - 2\frac{1}{2}$ "xWOF strips end to end. Press seams open. Fold prepared strip in half wrong sides together and press to make the binding.

Layer, Quilt and Bind
