NOTE: All seam allowances are $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ unless otherwise stated. Please read carefully through all instructions before you get started.

## MATERIALS LIST

All fabrics are from $44^{\prime \prime}$ wide quilt-weight For the quilt top
1 pad Cake Mix Recipe \#7 (CM7)
2 Junior Layer Cakes ${ }^{\text {Nu }}$ of prints
1 Layer Cake ${ }^{\text {rwM }}$ Bella Solid White (9900LC-98)
3 yards of Bella Solid White (9900-98)
For the backing $41 / 4$ yards
For the binding $1 / 2$ yard
$72^{\prime \prime} \times 78^{\prime \prime}$ piece of batting ( $80 \%$ cotton, $20 \%$ poly)

## 1. CUTTING THE FABRICS

From the Bella Solid White yardage, cut
2 horizontal border strips, each $67^{1} 1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$
9 horizontal sashing strips, each $671 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 1^{1 / 4 \prime \prime}$
2 squares $10 " \mathrm{x} 10$ " (add those to your white Layer Cake stack)
90 vertical sashing strips, each $61 / 2^{\prime \prime x} 11 / 4^{\prime \prime}$
200 rectangles $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 2{ }^{\prime \prime}$ (B)
107 squares 2 " x 2" (A)

## 2. ASSEMBLE THE BLOCKS

Cake Mix Recipe \#7 includes 44 recipe cards. One assembled Recipe Card yield four 3" finished half square triangles and sixteen $1 \frac{1}{1 / 2}$ finished half square triangles.
Following the instructions given by the Recipe Cards make a total of $144-3$ " finished half square triangles and 704-1 $1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ finished half square triangles.

## BLOCK 1

Following the below block assembly diagram make a total of 38 Blocks 1.

BLOCK 2
Following the below block assembly diagram make a total of 33 Blocks 2.


BLOCK 3
Following the below block assembly diagram make a total of 29 Blocks 3


Each block should measure $6 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 6 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ including seam allowances.
3. ASSEMBLE THE QUILT CENTER

Referring to the Quilt Assembly Diagram, lay out pieced blocks and sashing rectangles in 10 vertical rows. Sew together pieces in each row. Each pieced row should be $671 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 6^{1 / 2 "}$ including seam allowances.

Join pieced block rows and horizontal sashing rows to make quilt center. Press seams towards sashing strips. The quilt center should be $671 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 671 / 22^{\prime \prime}$ including seam allowances.

## 4. ADD BORDERS

Join each 22-3" finished half square triangles as shown in the below Quilt Assembly Diagram to form a border strip. It should measure $661 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ including seam allowances. Add a piece ( $1^{\prime \prime} \times 3{ }^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ ) of background to both ends to make it $671 / 2^{\prime \prime}$. Add each a background border strip and a pieced border strip to the top and bottom of the quilt center.

Build quilt-sandwich, quilt and bind.
