



A INSTRUCTIONS

SQUARE IN SQUARE: Make 4

Draw a line diagonally across the Fabric A and Fabric C squares. Place on corners of square of Fabric B. Sew on marked line. Trim excess.





QUARTER SQUARE TRIANGLES (QSTs): Make 4

Use Fabric A and Fabric C squares to onstruct QST blocks using your preferred method. If you need a refresher for constructing QST blocks, reference my <u>handy QST tutorial</u>!

Trim QST blocks to 21/2" /41/2" / 61/2"




Center Square

Cut square of Fabric D as listed in table.

Assemble Quilt Block

Assemble block with the square within the square blocks in the corners.
