## I INSTRUCTIONS

## SQUARE IN SQUARE: Make 4

Draw a line diagonally across the Fabric A and Fabric C squares. Place on corners of square of Fabric B. Sew on marked line. Trim excess.


## QUARTER SQUARE TRIANGLES (QSTs): Make 4

Use Fabric A and Fabric C squares to onstruct QST blocks using your preferred method. If you need a refresher for constructing QST blocks, reference my handy QST tutorial!

Trim QST blocks to $21 / 2 " / 41 / 2 " / 61 / 2$ "


## Center Square

Cut square of Fabric D as listed in table.

## Assemble Quilt Block

Assemble block with the square within the square blocks in the corners.


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
