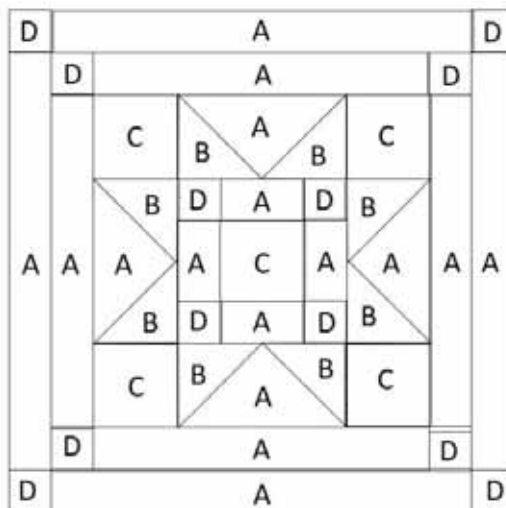
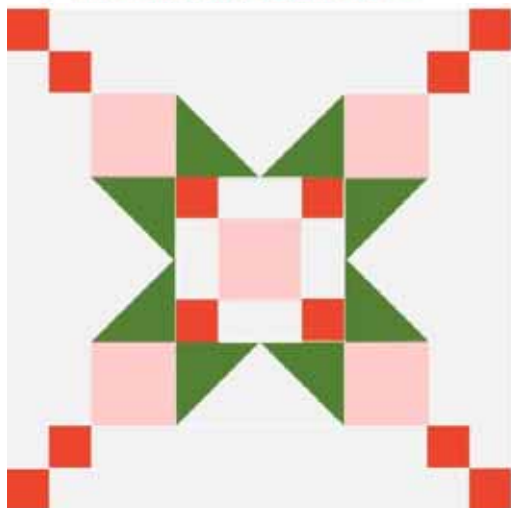


This blocks finishes at 6", 12" or 18" square.

|          | (4) .75" x 4.5" strips     | (4) 1.5" x 8.5" strips     | (4) 2" x 12.5" strips      |
|          | (4) .75" x 5.5" strips     | (4) 1.5" x 10.5" strips    | (4) 2" x 15.5" strips      |
| Fabric B | (8) 1.5" squares           | (8) 2.5" squares           | (8) 3.5" squares           |
| Fabric C | (5) 1.5" squares           | (5) 2.5" squares           | (5) 3.5" squares           |
| Fabric D | (12) .75" squares          | (12) 1.5" squares          | (12) 2" squares            |

Use the stitch and flip method to make flying geese. Make 4.

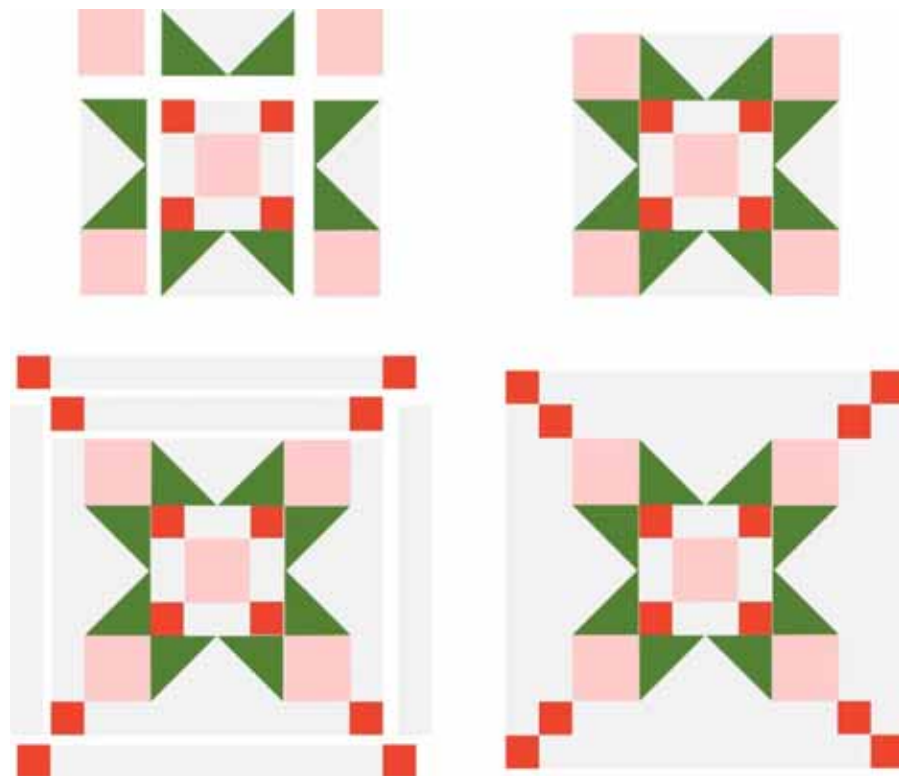


### BLOCK CENTER

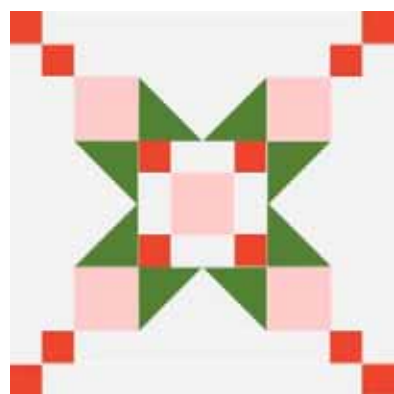
Join Fabric A, C, and D pieces as shown to create block center.
