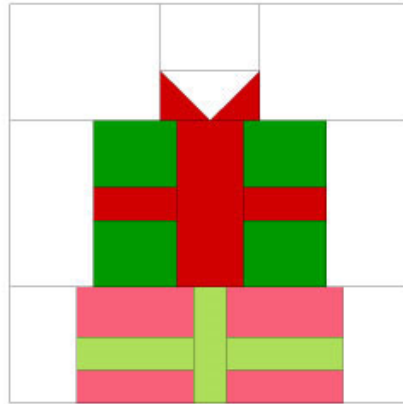
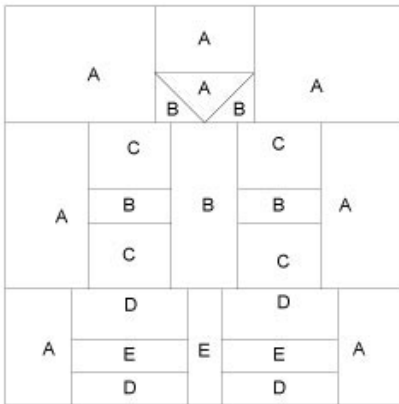
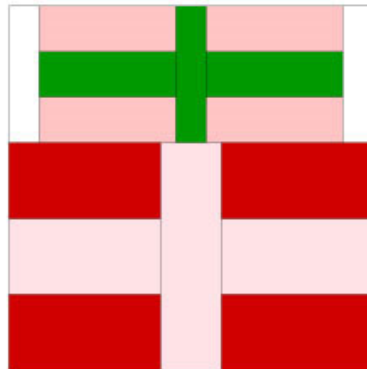
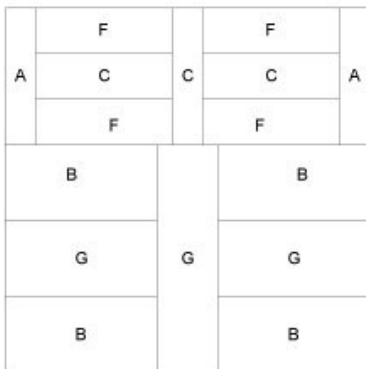


These blocks finish at 12" square OR 12" x 24" when you pile them up!

INGREDIENTS



	Block 1
A - Background	(2) 4" x 5" (1) 2.5" x 3.5" (1) 1.5" x 3.5" (2) 3" x 5.5" (2) 2.5" x 4"
B - Red	(2) 1.5" squares (1) 2.5" x 5.5" (2) 1.5" x 3"
C - Dark green	(4) 2.5" x 3"
D - Dark pink	(2) 1.5" x 4" (2) 2" x 4"
E - Light green	(3) 1.5" x 4"



	Block 2 (optional)
A - Background	(2) 1.5" x 5"
F - Medium pink	(4) 2" x 5"
C - Dark green	(2) 2" x 5" (1) 1.5" x 5"
B - Red	(4) 3" x 5.5"
G - Light pink	(2) 3" x 5.5" (1) 2.5" x 8"

INSTRUCTIONS

BLOCK 1

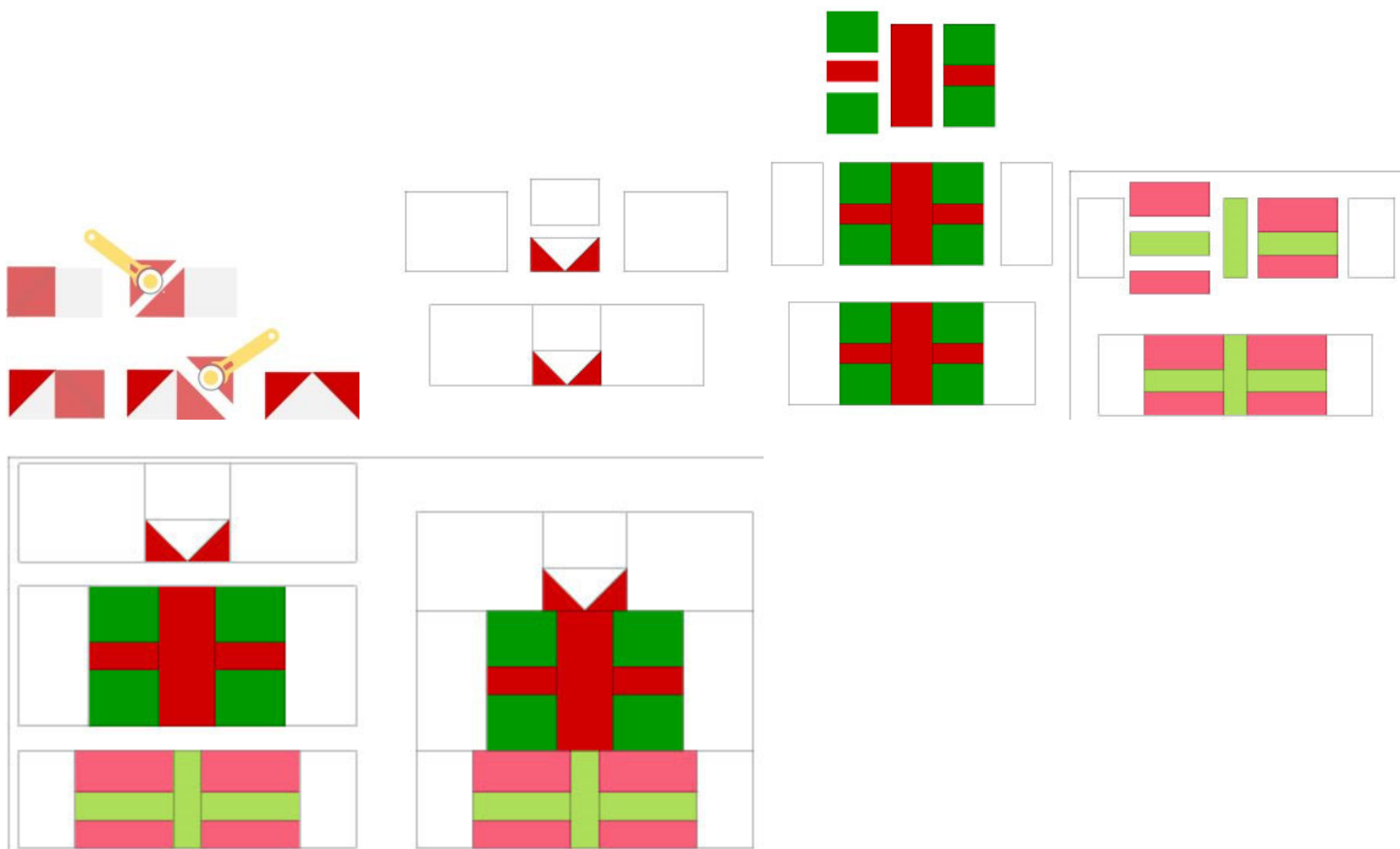
Make flying geese. Draw a pencil line on the wrong side of the diagonal of each red square. Match 1 square up the corner of background fabric rectangle. Sew on the marked line. Trim 1/4" away from seam and press.

Repeat on opposite corner.

Create the top unit of the gift by joining the flying geese unit with the background pieces:

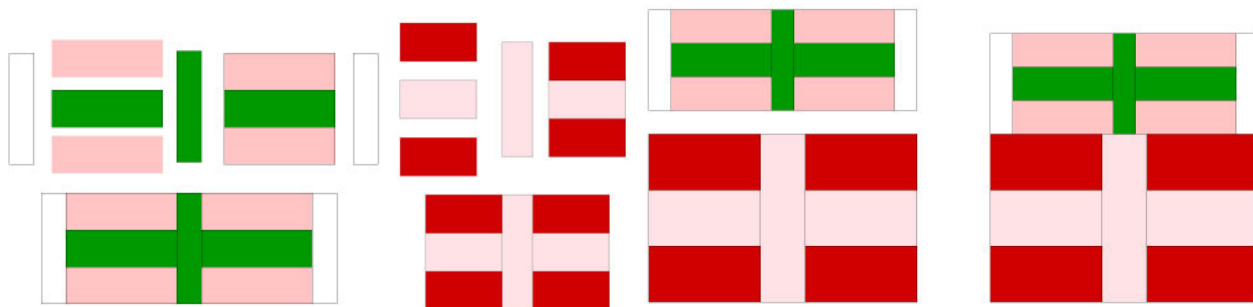
Create the body of gift #1 as shown. Create the body of gift #2 as shown. Note that the narrower pieces of the gift's main part are on the bottom of the block.

Combine all three units to complete Block 1:



BLOCK 2 (OPTIONAL)

Block 2 assembly is very simple. Join the pieces for gift #3 and gift #4 as shown below.



Join units to complete Block 2.



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
