



## INGREDIENTS

Blocks you will need: (5) 18 1/2" blocks, (4) 12 1/2" blocks and (20) 6 1/2" blocks.

Borders and Binding - 1 3/4 yards of fabric.

Backing - 4 yards

Batting - queen size.

## INSTRUCTIONS

**Assembly :** Make (4) groups consisting of (1) 12 1/2" block and (5) 6 1/2" blocks.

Follow grouping in picture below.

Stitch two 6 1/2" blocks together one above the other. Stitch these two blocks to the right or left side of your 12 1/2" block.

Stitch three 6 1/2" blocks together side by side. Stitch these three blocks to the top or bottom of your 12 1/2" block.

**Stitch rows together.**

Top row (1) 18 1/2" block to group of 12 1/2" and 6 1/2" blocks to 18 1/2" block.

Middle row (1) group of blocks to 18 1/2" block to group of blocks.

Bottom row (1) 18 1/2" block to group of blocks to (1) 18 1/2" block.

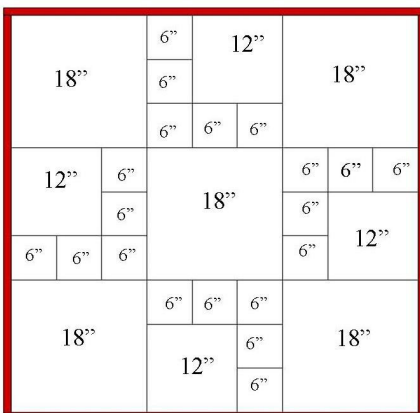
Stitch the three rows together.

**Borders** - Cut 2 strips 3 1/2" x 54 1/2" and stitch to sides of your quilt.

Cut 2 strips 3 1/2" x 61" and stitch to top and bottom of your quilt.

**Binding** - Cut 4 strips 2 1/2" x 72". Stitch these strips together. You will need approximately 245" for binding.
